14th Traversée de Paris, a new tribute to the cinema

The association **Vincennes en Anciennes**, the **Rencontres internationales du cinéma Patrimoine** and the **Prix Henri Langlois**, alongside the city of Vincennes and the **Conseil régional Ile-de-France**, are organising the first gathering of classic cars of the year.

An exceptional day in Paris

Prior to the celebration of the century of Henri Langlois's birth (founder of the French Cinémathèque), the *Traversée de Paris*, will wear its cinematographic outfit. The car is a very particular character on the roll; James Bond's Aston Martin, Harry Potter's Ford Anglia, Emmett Brown's DeLorean from *Back to the Future* could almost overshadow their owners! We all remember the Citroën Traction from the *Tontons flingueurs*, the 2CV from the *Corniaud*, the Volkswagen Beetle from *The love bug*, and the Fiat 500 from *Le grand bleu*. In 2012, starting its first association with the **Prix Henri Langlois**, The *Traversée de Paris* had welcomed its first sponsor: Claude Lelouch, behind the wheel of a Ford Mustang. This year, the *Traversée de Paris* will have two co-sponsors along with many people from the seventh art. The cinema will take the road on one of the most beautiful set in the world.



A unique show

There are few occasions to see so much classic cars gathered in the capital city. The 12 January 2014, it will be more than 600 vehicles (cars, motorbikes, platform buses, commercial vans...) to start the ride, at 8.00am from the esplanade of the *Chateau de Vincennes*, they will do the show all morning long through around 30km of main streets and places of the capital (*Daumesnil, Vosges, Vendôme, Concorde, Etoile, Trocadéro...*).

Cars will pass by the most beautiful monuments and stop sometimes.

The *Traversée de Paris* also offer a full overview of classic cars, with vehicles from France, Germany, America, England, Italy, Japan, Sweden, Russia, from all makers and all times. The youngest cars are 30-year old.

This event aims at valuing those who are and will do the cinema. More the 50 movies will be offered with people and professional of the cinema, allowing the public to go for a "timeless trip of pictures and emotion"..

This event, of which the official comity is presided by Claudia Cardinale, have welcomed among others Abbas Kiarostami, Roman Polanski, Georges Lautner, Ken Loach, Alain Resnais, Hanna Schygulla, Marina Vlady, Marisa Berenson, Carole Bouquet, Sandrine Bonnaire, Michael Lonsdale, Marc Lavoine, Clovis Cornillac... and will end the Monday 3 February 2014 with the **9th Prix Henri Langlois** ceremony, under the mentorship of **Manufactor "Créateur d'émotions"**, with many guests of which some will attend the 14th *Traversée de Paris*.



Vincennes en Anciennes is the first French association of classic cars multi-carmakers.

Created in 1998, the association welcomes more than 900 members, which represents a park of 2.500 vehicles.

The administrators are also active members in carmaker clubs. The first Sunday of every month, the Association meets on the

esplanade of the *Château de Vincennes*.

It joins in national or local initiatives as the *Heritage Days*, *Telethon*, research against *Trisomy 21*, the *Bleuet de France*.
